MECHANICS:

1. PICE Chapters should identify specific area(s) for operation.
2. Coordinate with the Local Government Unit where the Clean-up Operation will be held.
3. Take photos of site(s) Before and After the Clean up and submit to PICE preferably on March 31, 2012.
4. Each PICE Chapter shall mobilize at least 31 regular and/or student members.
5. PICE National shall prepare a Standard Design for streamers, signs and T- Shirts.
6. Leaflet Campaign Materials on Climate Change, Flood Control and care for the Environment with the role of the citizens will be prepared by PICE National, as well as the Press Kit and Releases.
7. Chapters are to gather at least 31 kgs of rubbish that may clog the waterways.
8. Incentive to Chapters will be given out.
